




ReadSpeaker in Brightspace

QUICK START GUIDE

GETTING STARTED COULDN'T BE EASIER!

In the content area of Brightspace, simply select the type of content to be read.

1. Listening to HTML pages.

Select the text you want to listen to and click the Listen button. An audio player will appear and ReadSpeaker will begin reading the text you have selected.



In the player you can:

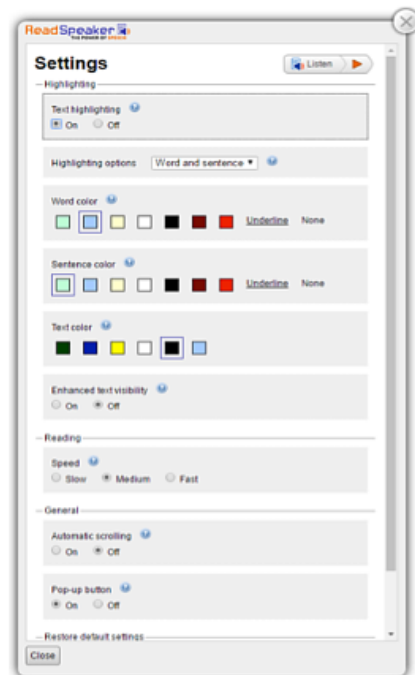
- Pause/restart the reading
- Stop the reading
- Use the progress bar to navigate in the audio
- Adjust the volume
- Click the settings icon to adjust the reading settings
- Click the download icon to download the audio file
- Close the player

Use tab/shift+tab to navigate inside the player and press enter to activate a certain button or link.

Settings

Click the settings (cog icon) and you can choose:

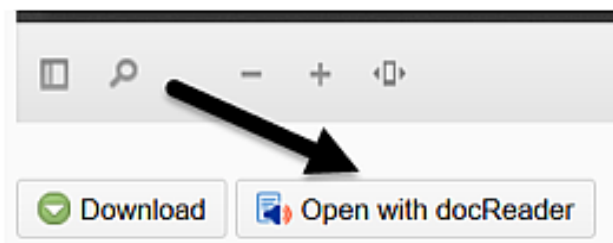
- to have the text highlighted while read
- to have the text highlighted by word and sentence, sentence only, or word only
- style and colors for the highlighting
- slow, medium, or fast reading speed
- to scroll automatically to follow the highlighted text
- if you want the pop-up Listen button to be shown when text is selected



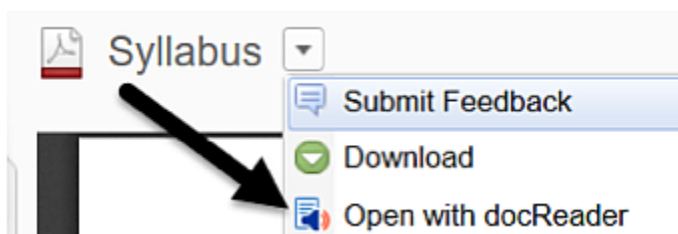

2. Listening to Documents, PDF's, PowerPoints and more with docReader.

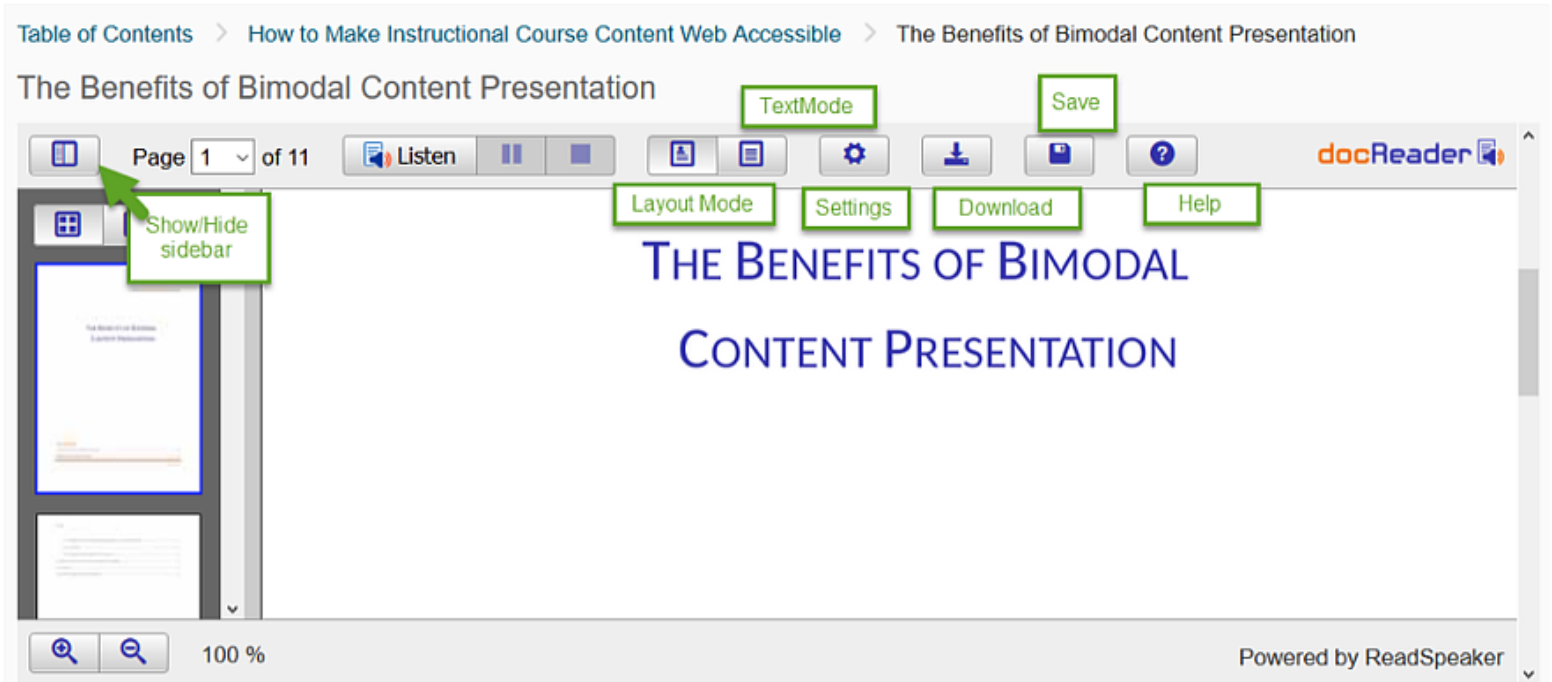
Click the title of the document and listen to content with docReader from the top or bottom of the dialogue box.



Select '**Open with docReader**'

Layout Mode-For documents with lots of images you may want to use Text Mode to remove the images.



Download- create a MP3 version and go mobile with your content.

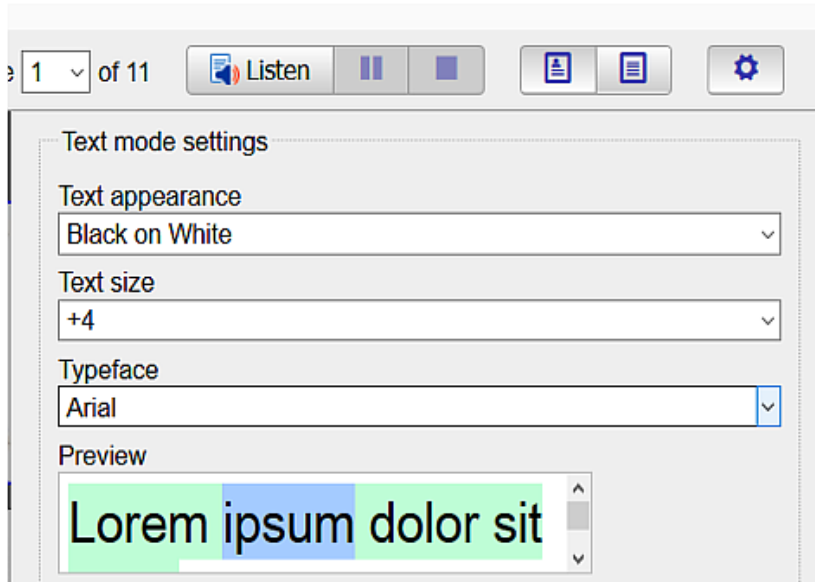
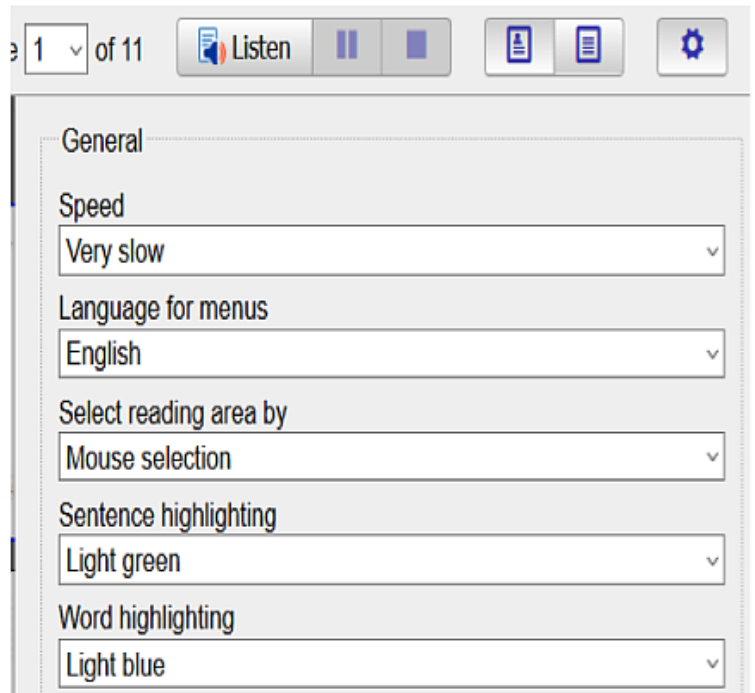

Settings
